# AI and automation lead the charge

Eighty percent of respondents identified AI-driven tools and automation as essential for improving workflows, cutting costs, and fostering innovation. **Fifty-five percent say they are actively investing in automation tools, cloud-based management solutions, and predictive maintenance technologies** to stay ahead in a competitive market. This data indicates that while most print producers recognize the need for automation to drive the growth and success of their businesses, fewer are taking concrete steps toward investing in these technologies.

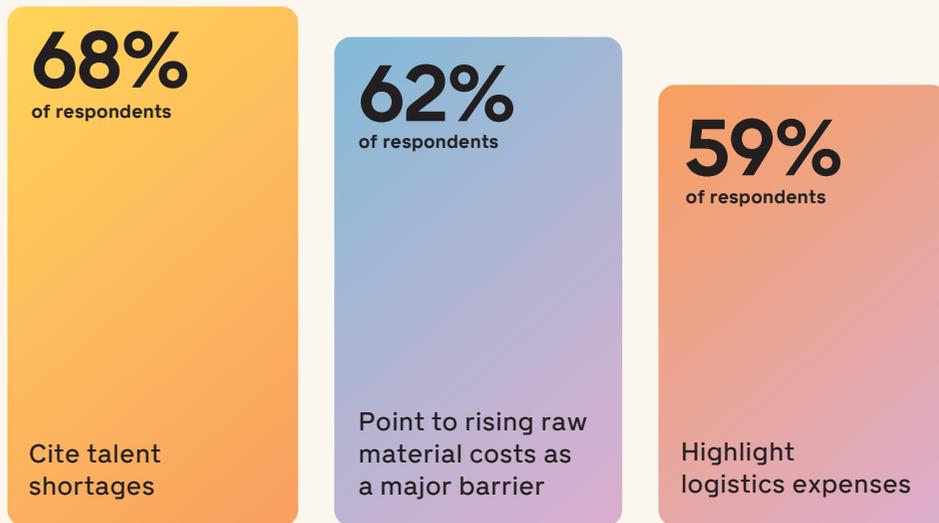

# Top challenges for 2025

While print production is ripe with opportunity, many print producers are experiencing similar mounting challenges. 68% of respondents cite talent shortages as a significant challenge, while 62% point to rising raw material costs as a major barrier. Logistics expenses and supply chain disruptions were highlighted by 59% of participants, making these critical pain points across the industry.

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*Attracting the next generation of talent is critical to your business success and goes hand in hand with increased automation. Today's talent is driven to increase their skillsets with technology.*

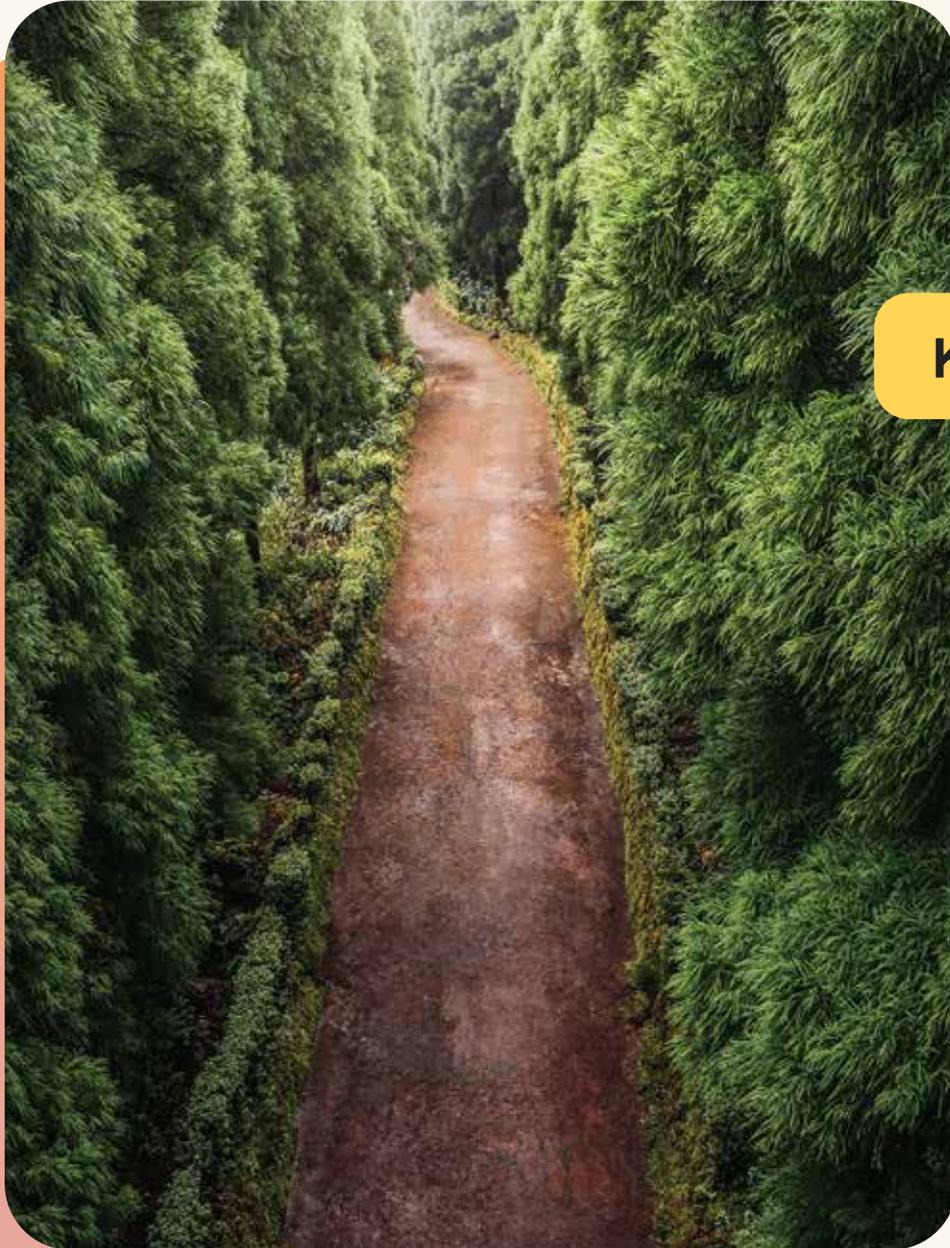

# Sustainability gains momentum

Seventy percent of respondents report growing demand for sustainable and eco-friendly products. This trend is driving investments in sustainability-focused technologies and localized supply chains. Additionally, 60% of respondents cite shorter turnaround times and reduced environmental impact as standard customer expectations. As consumers demand products that are smarter, faster, and greener, sustainability and profitability are increasingly intertwined.

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*Most people agree sustainability matters – if there’s a feasible option to be greener, why wouldn’t you? But in reality, as businesses balance challenges and work to grow profits, sustainability can seem like a ‘nice to have’ instead of a ‘must have’. That’s changing – sustainability is becoming a non-negotiable. Consumers, especially millennials and Gen Z, demand transparency. They want to know where their products come from, who made them, and how they were produced. Sustainability considerations are huge with today’s consumers.*

*And that’s good news. Consumer demand is tightly linking profitability and sustainability. So, what’s good for the environment is good for your business. The business option for print producers is clear here too. They can move to an on demand and local production model. Producing customized goods on demand – as opposed to in mass – reduces waste. Local production near the end consumer cuts transportation emissions while supporting local communities. Because of consumer demands and ease of implementation, 2025 will be the year print prioritizes sustainability.*

# Digital over offset

Seventy-five percent of respondents report a significant shift toward digital production, with 50% of their revenue or more now stemming from digital printing. Web-to-print platforms are increasingly favored, with 65% of printers adopting these solutions to streamline operations, enhance flexibility, and meet rising demand. While print producers have known the future is digital for quite some time, the data show, the future is now.

The shift toward digital printing

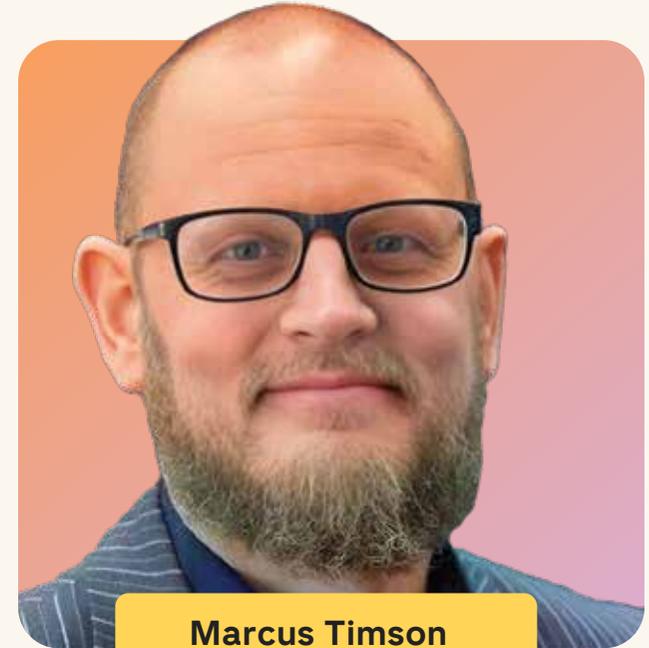

# Emerging trends

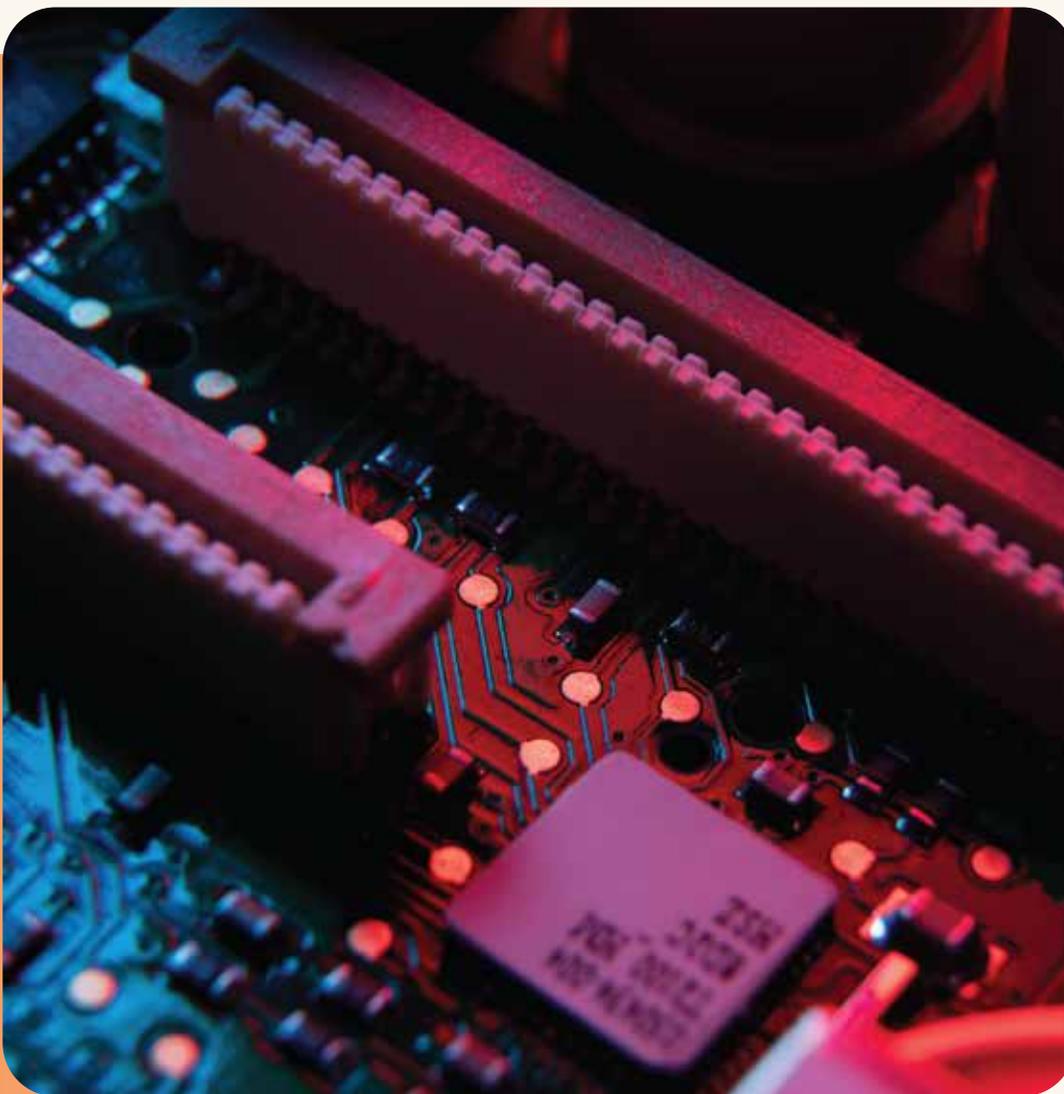

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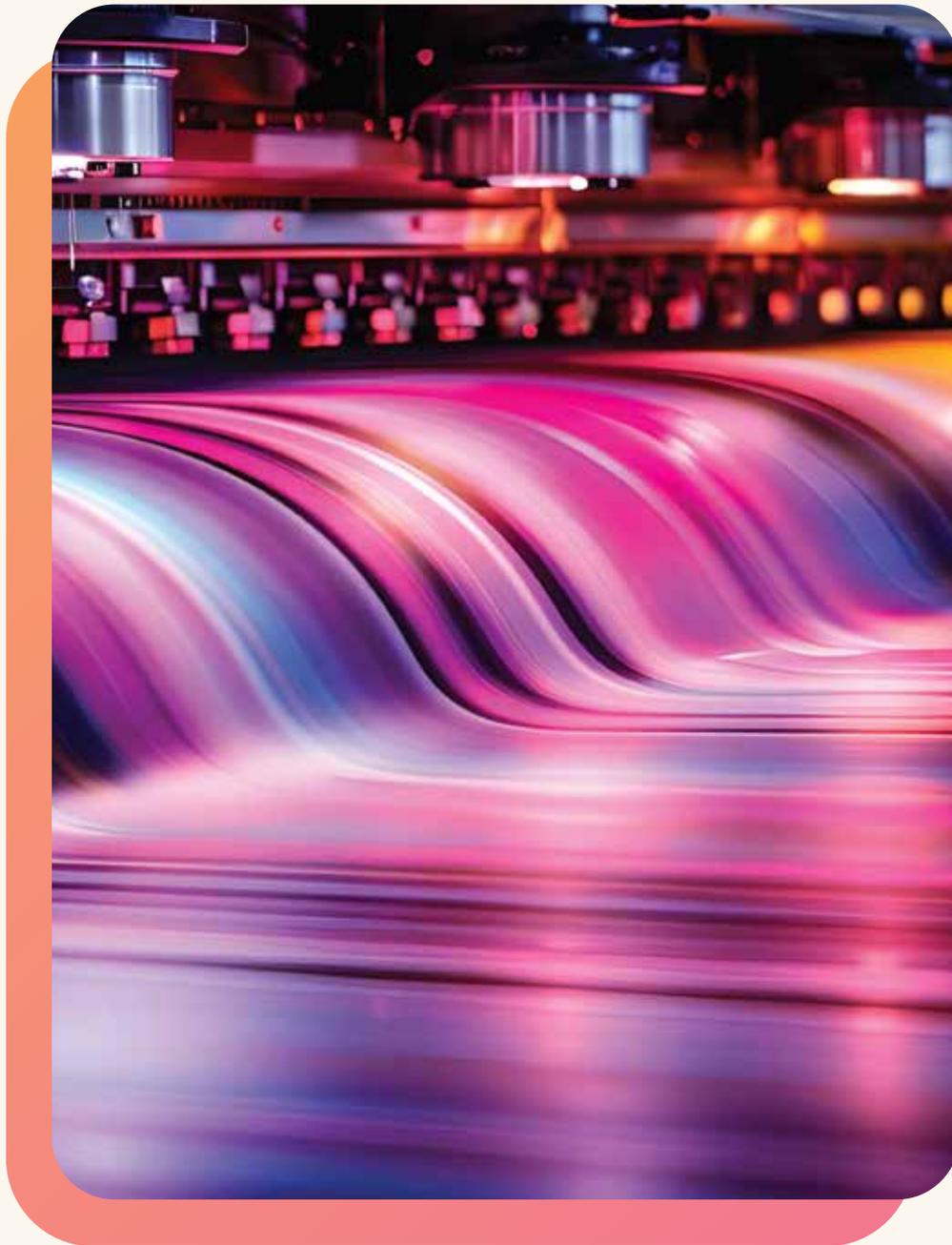
*The printing industry stands at the intersection of two powerful macro trends that will significantly accelerate technology investment in 2025.*

*First, shifting buying patterns among global enterprises, the creator economy, and consumer brands are driving a migration toward on-demand production and environmentally conscious manufacturing. Localized production is rapidly evolving into a practical, cost-saving imperative, fueled by recent changes in global trade agreements and new cross-border tariffs. As cost efficiencies align with environmental benefits, on-demand, localized production is no longer optional—it’s the future of competitive business models.*

*Second, AI is redefining the very foundation of innovation. New AI models are now performing tasks at levels once thought exclusive to top scientists, developers, and mathematicians. Microsoft’s CEO envisions a seismic shift from traditional software-as-a-service (SaaS) to “service as software,” where AI agents will leverage massive data repositories to autonomously execute complex tasks. This evolution has the potential to radically streamline business operations, transforming industries from the inside out.*

*By March, 75% of the code for Gelato will be written by AI allowing the company to accelerate new features to support the print industry leaders.*
